


The Lord's Prayer Garland

How to use this resource

Paper Garland

Print out the flags on heavy paper weight (or various colors of paper) and cut them out leaving a fold leaf on the top edge for attaching a string. You may want to resize the flags before printing them. To do this, simply select the number of pages on your printing settings (e.g. 2 per page, if you select 6 per page all the flags fit on one letter size paper).

The designs with block letter font are ideal for coloring while praying.

Attach the cut-out flags on a string or ribbon with tape, wood clothespins, of punch holes in the corners and string the cord through the holes.

Painted Fabric Garland with Textile Markers or Textile/Acrylic Paints

Print out the prayer flags in a desired size. Cut the fabric to match the printed pattern. Use masking tape to attach the paper patterns and the fabric on a window (to increase visibility for tracing). Trace the pattern on the fabric with a fabric marker or pencil. Use textile paints or acrylic paints and a small brush to paint the designs and words on the fabric. Optionally use textile markers to draw. Let dry. To attach, use wood clothespins or sew a tube on the top edge of the flags and string through a natural cord. You may want to add beads, ribbons, or other elements to the garland.

Embroidery Fabric Garland

Start off by follow the instructions above until you have traced the designs and words on your fabric of choice (I recommend high thread count fabrics and strong contrast between the color of thread and fabric for a good visibility). Take an embroidery needle, embroidery floss (of your color choice) and attach the flag on an embroidery hoop. Separate one or two (depending on how thick lines you want) threads from the floss. Use simple backstitch to embroider the designs on each of flags. Sew separate backing pieces on the backs of the flags to cover the loose thread ends and knots. You may like to sew a ribbon onto the tops of the flags instead of creating a loop for a movable string.

Write Own Prayers

We included a wordless version of the prayer which allows you to write your own prayers, or use different translations of the prayer on the flags.

About the Creators



5. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.


What leads you away from love, God, yourself and others? Ask God to help you to stay away from such things.




6. For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

YOUR KINGDOM COME, YOUR WILL BE DONE, ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN.




